## Did You Know?

Mezcal (traditionally spelled mescal) is a Mexican distilled spirit that is made from the agave plant. Tequila is technically a mezcal, however, there are differences in production technique and in the types of agave used. It also tends to taste sweeter, or richer, than tequila.

# *Churros*

A churro is a fried-dough pastry—predominantly choux-based snack. Churros are traditional in Spain and Portugal, where they originated, as well as the Philippines and Ibero-America.

Spanish churros and Mexican churros are very similar. Spanish churros are coated in sugar and served with a thick dipping chocolate. Mexican churros are coated in a cinnamon sugar mixture and served with chocolate, caramel, or whipped cream or eaten plain.

# Sopapillas

Unlike sopapillas, beignets are made from yeast dough. And that's pretty much the only difference between the two. That's why you'll notice that sopapillas are light and flaky, while beignets are soft and doughy through and through, just like your traditional American doughnut.



# Flan

Our word for flan actually is derived from the Latin, "flado" (meaning flat cake), which became "flaon" in Old French. Interestingly, flan found two different outlets. In Spain it became a sweet custard generally made with caramelized sugar.
